

# Venue: Otley Hall

## A description from the Otley Hall website

Otley Hall, a grade I listed historic house in Suffolk, has a long and distinguished history and is situated in ten acres of beautiful gardens.

We are licenced to hold civil ceremonies and have three rooms for this purpose. The Great Hall with original 16th century features overlooks the rose and croquet lawns and can hold 60. The Gosnold Suite, adjacent to the main building holds 90, and the Linenfold Parlour, lined with superb linenfold wood panelling is perfect for more intimate occasions and holds 25. We welcome civil marriages, civil partnerships, marriage blessings and naming ceremonies.

A Grade 1 listed building, the house is a perfect example of unspoiled late medieval architecture. Particularly impressive are the Great Hall and Linenfold Parlour, both of which look out onto the Rose Garden.



## Location

Otley Hall is 8 miles north of Ipswich off the B1079 in the village of Otley. Once in the village, turn into Chapel Road at the Post Office/Village Stores and follow the brown tourist signs to Otley Hall.
